We have created a club booking code. The code allows you to book spaces that have been specifically reserved for Pacific Northwest Nordic Tug Owners Group . Your group code is: **nordic2025**. You may book a longer stay if you like!

Please follow these steps to make your reservation for your boat online. If you are unable to book online, please call so we can make the reservation over the phone.

Click [HERE](#) to go directly to the reservation page, or go to www.swantownmarina.com, and choose “Book Here”.

Enter your arrival and departure dates and the length, beam and draft of your boat.

Choose either 120V/Single 30 Amp or 120V/Single 50 Amp depending on your electrical needs. We have limited 50A pedestals available, and we will try to accommodate your needs to our best ability.

Enter your Group Code: **nordic2025**

Scroll to the offer **2025** Pacific Northwest Nordic Tug Owners Group. and click “Select”. At a later point in the reservation, if needed you can add specific requests for a certain type of space, and we will try to accommodate your request as best as possible (e.g. port side tie or linear moorage preferred).

Click the bright green “Start Booking” button to continue your booking.

Complete your booking by following the prompts for information about yourself, your boat and your payment method.

Once you have completed your reservation, you will receive confirmation of your booking and slip assignment. You will be assigned to the most optimal slip for your size vessel. Boats of your club will be grouped together automatically.

We have reserved slips for Pacific Northwest Nordic Tug Owners Group until **May 16th, 2025, at which time a reservation request must be completed**. On May 16, all un-reserved slips will be released to public. Once released all reservations will be based on availability.
